Contra Costa Sheriff's Department Qualification Course of Fire

The same course of fire will be used for the initial qualification as the renewal qualification and any other qualifications. All courses of fire will begin with a loaded gun, in the holster. The shooting proficiency exam will consist of a total of 18rds per gun or 15rds per 5 shot revolver. On the commence fire command, the shooter will:

- 10 yards – Draw, fire 6rds (15 seconds) then, reload (off the clock)
- 7 yards – Draw, fire 6rds (10 seconds) then, reload (off the clock)
- 5 yards – Draw, fire 6rds (5 seconds) then, reload (off the clock)

To pass, the shooter must achieve 100% of their shots (18 out of 18) in the large thoracic hit zone (14" x 16") of a TQ-15 target or similar paper or steel target, and demonstrate proficiency with gun safety, gun functionality, gun manipulations, shooting fundamentals and accuracy. A total of 2 attempts per gun, per day will be allowed.

Violations of gun safety will result in immediate removal from the range with no refund.
