Woodland Police Department CCW Qualification Course of Fire

The same course of fire will be used for the initial qualification as the renewal qualification and any other qualifications. All courses of fire will begin with a loaded gun, in the holster. The shooting proficiency exam will consist of a total of 60rds per gun. The below listed course of fire will be performed with each gun twice. The first run will be a practice run. The second run will be the actual scored qualification. On the commence fire command, the shooter will:

- 10 yards – Draw, fire 5rds, reload, fire 5rds (no time limit)
- 7 yards – Draw, fire 5rds, reload, fire 5rds (no time limit)
- 3 yards – Draw, fire 5rds, reload, fire 5rds (no time limit)

To pass, the shooter must achieve a minimum of 80% of their shots (24 out of 30) in the small thoracic hit zone (9" x 9.5") of a TQ-15 target or similar paper or steel target, and demonstrate proficiency with gun safety, gun functionality, gun manipulations, shooting fundamentals and accuracy. A total of 2 attempts per gun, per day will be allowed. **Violations of gun safety will result in immediate removal from the range with no refund.**
