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Sacramento CCW Qualification Course of Fire

The same course of fire will be used for the initial course as the renewal course and any other qualifications. All courses of fire will begin with a loaded gun, in the holster. The shooting proficiency exam will consist of a total of 100rds per gun. The below listed courses of fire must be repeated twice per firearm. The first time through is considered a practice run. The second time through is the actual test. On the commence fire command, the shooter will:

- 15 yards – Draw, fire 6rds in 30 seconds
- 7 yards – Draw, fire 6rds standing, reload, fire 6rds kneeling, reload while kneeling, fire 2rds kneeling in 45 seconds
- 7 yards – Draw, fire 6rds in 10 seconds
- 7 yards – Draw, fire 6rds one-handed (dominant), reload, switch hands, fire 6rds one-handed (non-dominant) in 25 seconds
- 5 yards – Draw, fire 3rds in 4 seconds
- 5 yards – Draw, fire 3rds in 4 seconds
- 3 yards – Draw, fire 2rds in 3 seconds
- 3 yards – Draw, fire 2rds in 3 seconds
- 3 yards – Draw, fire 2rds in 3 seconds

To pass, the shooter must achieve a minimum of 80% of their shots (40 out of 50) in the *large* center thoracic cavity hit zone (14" x 16") of a TQ-15 target and demonstrate proficiency with gun safety, gun functionality, gun manipulations, shooting fundamentals and accuracy. All shots fired must impact the body silhouette. A total of 2 attempts per gun, per day will be allowed. **Violations of gun safety will result in immediate removal from the range with no refund.**
